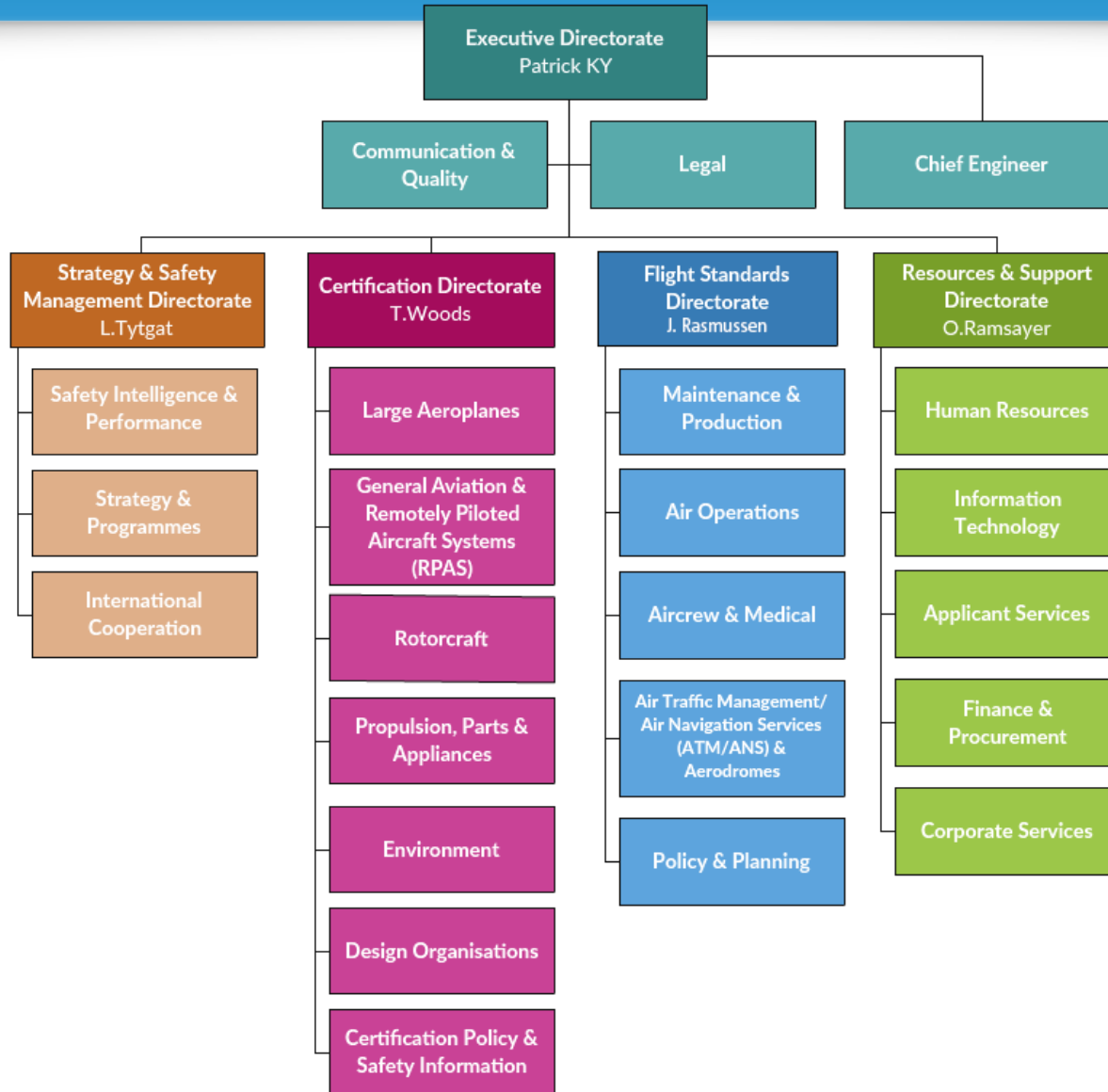


EASA Building Cologne/Germany





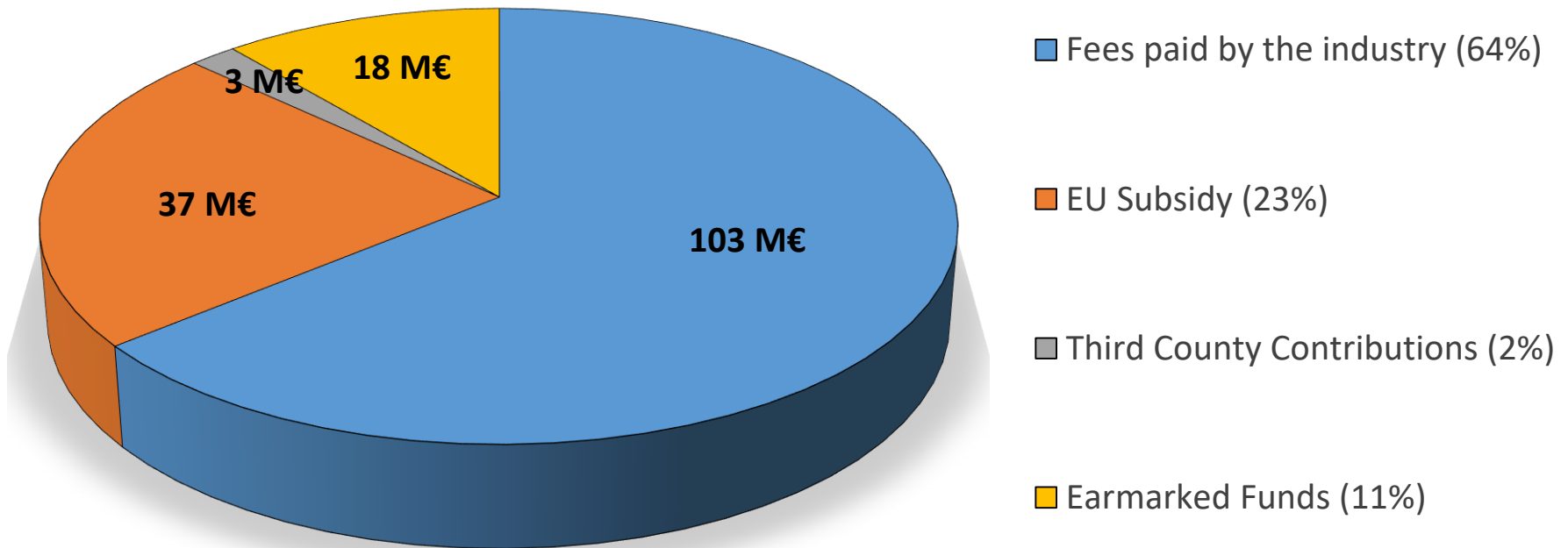
Organisation Chart

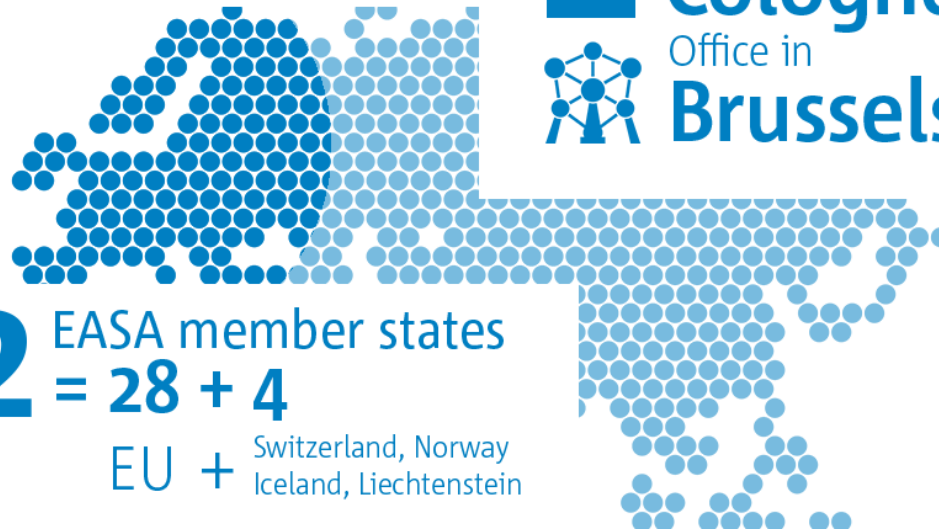

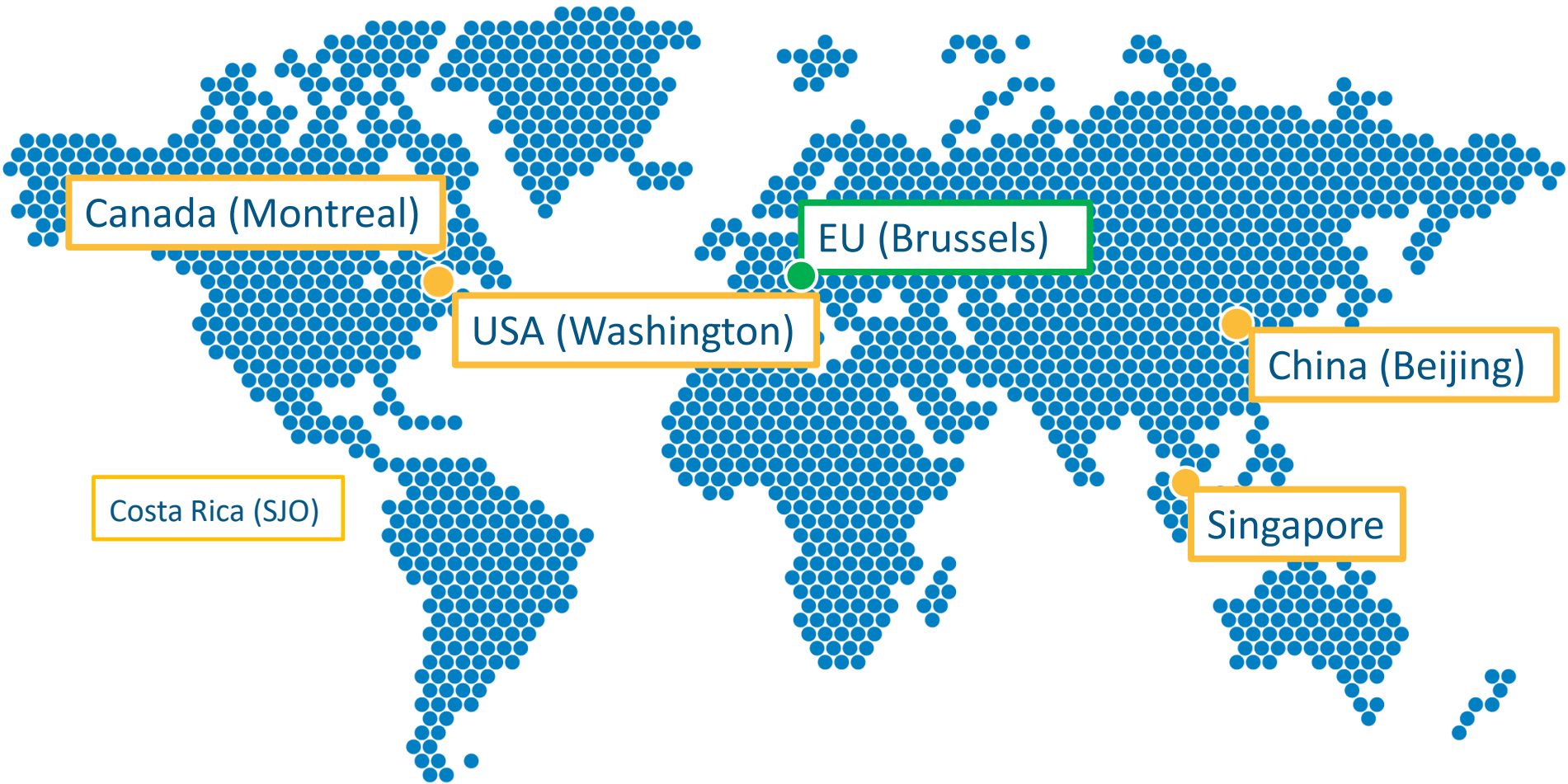

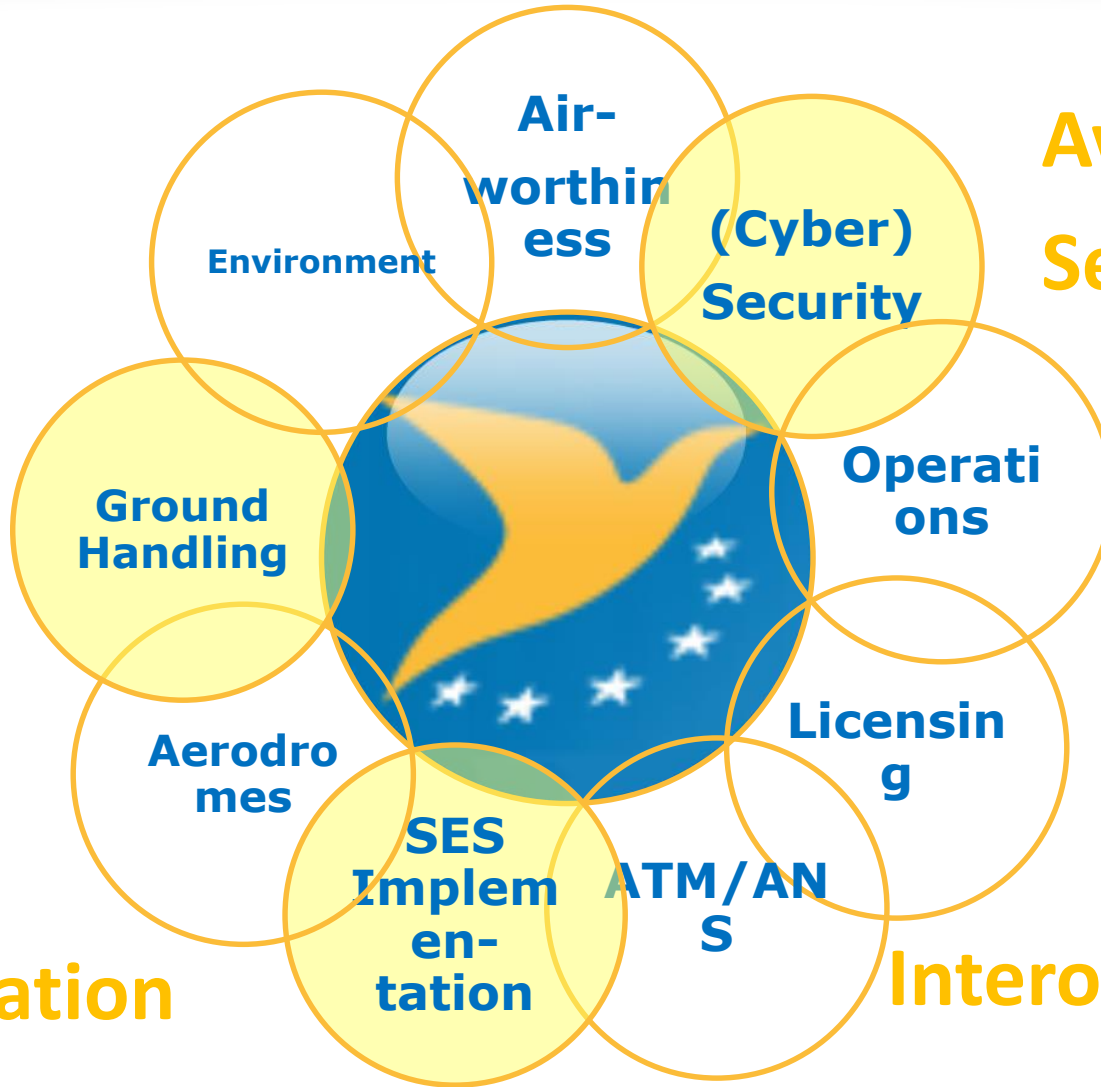
