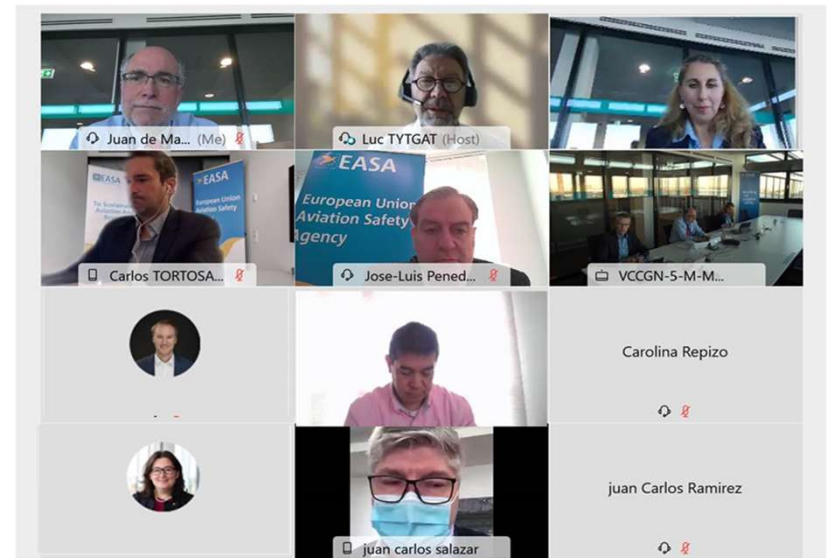
→ Managed by **European Union Aviation Safety Agency** in cooperation with main aviation partners (ICAO, RSOOs, CAAs, industry)

The situation required reassessing the scope and approach of the project's activities for the rest of the year, shifting the focus to remote support and webinars

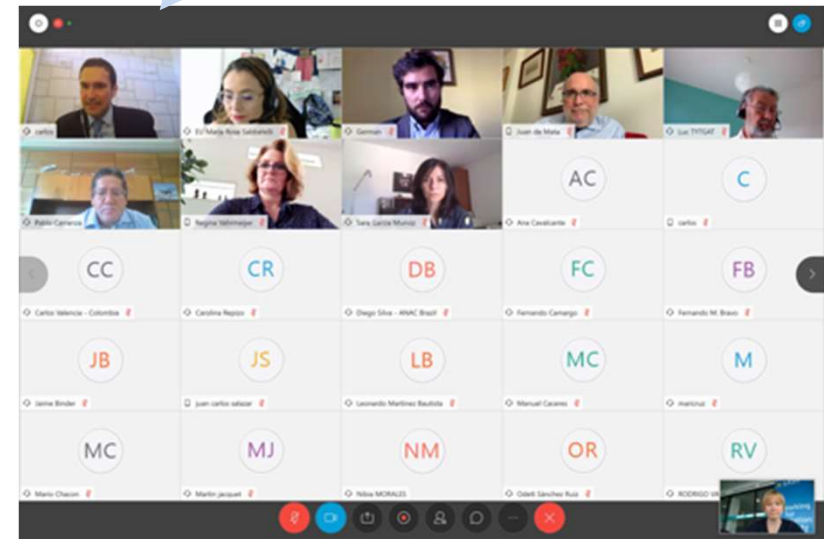
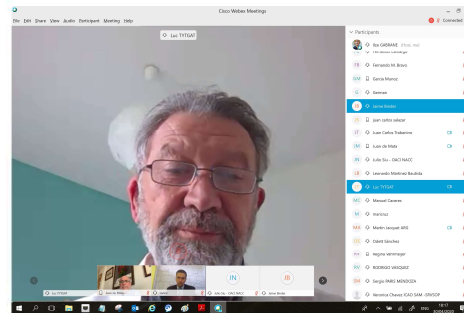

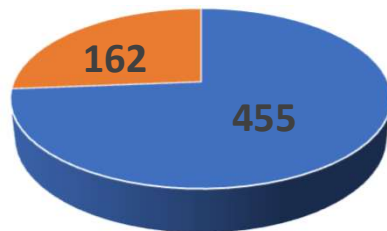

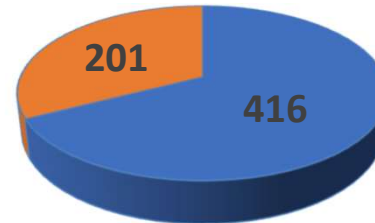

Participants per sector

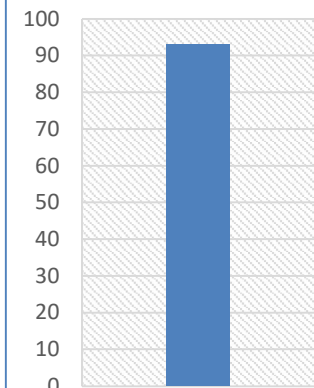

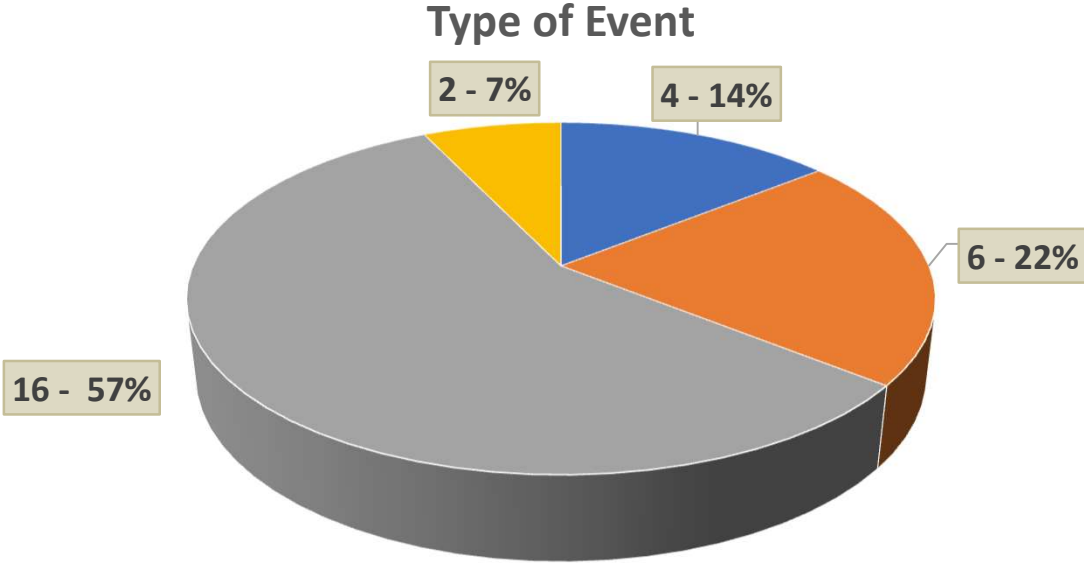
